**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the City Clerk at the City Clerk's Office, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Wall Street Building, 2930 Wetmore, Everett, Washington 98201, until **2:00 PM (local time), on Tuesday, June 4, 2002** for the construction of the “COMBINED SEWER IMPROVEMENTS “D” ” Project and will then and there be opened and publicly read aloud.

The project consists of the construction of approximately 10,000 linear feet of combined sewer replacement. The project is described more completely in the contract documents, entitled City of Everett, Washington, “COMBINED SEWER IMPROVEMENTS “D” ”. The cost estimate for this work is \$3,000,000 to \$3,500,000.

All proposals must be made upon the regular forms provided in the Proposal Section of the contract documents and must be accompanied by a bid bond or certified check in an amount not less than 5% of the successful bid to guarantee faithful performance of the contract.

The bidders attention is directed to a change in the reporting of subcontractors at bid time. The bidder is to list all subcontractors on the proposal who will be performing more than 10% of the contract. See the Proposal Section for the Subcontractor's form.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and waive any irregularities or informalities. No bidder may withdraw his bid after the hour set for the opening thereof. The City further reserves the right to make the bid award as deemed in the best interest of the City.

The right is reserved by the City to postpone the award for a period of forty-five (45) days after bid opening. The Contractor will be required to comply with all local, State, and Federal laws and regulations pertaining to equal employment opportunities.
